

 - d) Add "Do not make more than 6 applications per site per year" after every "Repeat treatment every 14 days".

- e) Following the second sentence under Pests on Outside Surfaces of Building add: "Hold can 2 to 3 feet from surface to be treated and pray to slightly moisten surface".
- f) Replace the second sentence under Crawling Insects with the following: "Hold can 2 to 3 feet from surface to be treated and spray infested surface of patio or picnic area hitting as many insects as possible. Spray to slightly moisten surface".
- g) Delete "Flammable" under Physical or Chemical Hazards. The flame extension for this product is 0 inches.

Note, that this product will remain conditionally registered until review of efficacy studies and the generic data for etofenprox are completed. These data were imposed on similar products containing the active ingredient etofenpox and registered to Mitsui Chemicals Inc. Once the required data have been evaluated, EPA will entertain an application to amend the registration of the subject product to allow unconditional use around outdoor residential sites.

3. Please submit two (2) copies of your final printed label for before your release the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Pests on Outside Surfaces of Buildings: For control of building infestation due to Ants, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes, and Sowbugs (Pillbugs). Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance, up to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as a residual spray to outside surface of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include (but are not limited to) screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and refuse dumps. Repeat treatment every 14 days.

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Hornets and Yellow Jackets. Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes, or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas
