CORROSIVE

FIRST AID

If On Skin Or Clothing:	- Take off contaminated clothing. - Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 - 20 minutes. - Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If Swallowed:	- Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. - Have a sip of water if able to swallow. - Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. - Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment.

Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
