

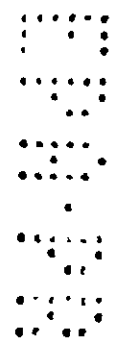

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Paper Manufacturing (for control of bacteria, fungi and algae)

Dosing: Additions should be made at a point in the system where mixing action is good, e.g. raw stock chest beater or mixing unit.

Intermittent Dosing: Add 3-6 fluid ounces (84-168 ppm) of Tolcide MW-10 per ton of paper (dry weight).

Continuous Dosing: Add 2-4.5 fluid ounces (56-126 ppm) of Tolcide MW-10 per ton of paper (dry weight).

Industrial and/or Commercial Recirculating Cooling Water Systems and Evaporative Condensers (for control of bacteria, fungi and algae)

Initial Slug Dose: Add 6-12 fluid ounces (46-92 ppm) of Tolcide MW-10 per 1000 gallons of water daily until control is obtained. Thereafter, add either **Intermittently** 3-6 fluid ounces (24-42 ppm) of Tolcide MW-10 or **Continuously** 1.5-6 fluid ounces (11.5-47 ppm) of Tolcide MW-10 per day.
