**FORMULA 700** is a one-step disinfectant cleaner that is effective against a broad spectrum of bacteria, is virucidal, fungicidal, and will prevent the growth of mold and mildew and their odors when used as directed.

**FORMULA 700** is an effective one-step sanitizer-cleaner for use on non-food contact surfaces.

When used as directed, **FORMULA 700** will deodorize surfaces in toilet areas, behind and under sinks and counters, garbage cans and garbage storage areas, and other places where bacterial growth can cause mal odors.

**GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**Formula 700** is a proven one-step disinfectant-cleaner-sanitizer-fungicide-mildewstat-virucide which is effective in water up to 400 ppm hardness in the presence of 5% serum contamination.

Apply **Formula 700** to walls, floors and other hard (non-porous) surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks, tile, porcelain, and bedframes with a cloth mop or mechanical spray device so as to thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

**Disinfection:** For disinfecting hard non-porous surfaces in hospitals add 2 oz per gallon of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. At 1/2 oz per gallon of water **FORMULA 700** will disinfect hard non-porous surfaces in school, industry, and non-medical institutions.

**2 oz per gallon use-level:** The activity of **Formula 700** has been evaluated in the presence of 5% serum and 400 ppm hard water by the AOAC use dilution test and found to be effective against a broad spectrum of gram negative and gram positive organisms as represented by:

**For schools, industry and non-medical institution use:** At 1/2 oz per gallon of water **FORMULA 700** delivers excellent cleaning and germicidal effectiveness. It is effective against Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, Escherichia coli, and Serratia marcescens. The same AOAC tests used to confirm performance for hospitals were used.

**Fungicidal Control:** **FORMULA 700** is an effective fungicide against Trichophyton mentagrophytes (the athlete's foot fungus) when used on surfaces in areas such as locker rooms, dressing rooms, showers and bath areas, etc. at 2 oz per gallon.

**Mold and Mildew Control:** At 1/2 oz per gallon of **FORMULA 700** is effective in preventing the growth of mold and mildew and the odors caused by them when applied to hard non-porous surfaces as indicated in general instructions above. 
4. The revised Confidential Statement of Formula submitted December 17, 1982, is accepted and has been placed in your file.
