DIRECTIONS (8-8-100 is Same as 4-4-50)

APRICOTS PLUIS GOUR CHERRIES: Brown rot and Leaf spot, use 4 TBD. per gallon plus equal amount of lime. Do not use on Japanese plums. Use at shuck split stage and in first and second cover sprays.

Leaf curl, use 12 THS/cal. in early spring. Repeat late fall after leaf

PECAN: Scab, use 6 TEb/gal. when catkins show. Repeat 3 or 4 times at 3-week intervals. Spanish moss, use 12 THS/gal. Spray during winter.

GRAPES: Black rot and milder, use 6 TBS/gal. when shoots are 10 inches long. Repeat after bloom and 10 days later, again in mid-August.

POTATORS: Early and late blight, use 8 TEC/gal. Apply when plants are 3 to 4 inches high, maintain a 10 to li-day schedule for entire season.

STRAWHERRY: Leaf spot, use 6 THS/gal. at 10 to li-day intervals, except during

CITRUS: Lemon brown rot, grapefruit scab, melanose, use 6 TB/mal. Spray just before spring flush. Repeat 1 to 3 weeks after bloom.

TOPATO: Early and late blight, Septoria leaf spot, use 6 THS/gal. Reseat at 7 to 10-day intervals. Alternate with Zineb 75W if Anthracnose is a problem.

SYCAMORES LINDEN MAPLE OAK TULIP TREE Kills Control of Anthracnoce, Leaf Spot and Kim Leaf Curl, use 6 THS/gal. as leaves uncurl in spring. Robest in 2 to 3 weeks.

JUNIPER CEDAR CYPRESS ARBORVITAE SPRICE PINE YEW: For Needle Cast, Sphaeropsis blight, Twig blight, Coryneum blight, apply fall and spring using 8 TBS/gal. Spray Cedar and Junipers July-August for Cedar Apple Rust.

IVY: Leaf Spot, use 6 TBS/gal. in spring. Repeat in 11 days or at first sign of disease.

LAUREL LILAC RHODOD MDRUM: Leaf Spots and blight, use 4 THS/gal. in early spring. Again after blooms.

DOGWOOD BOXWOOD CAHELLIAS: Dieback, Leaf Spot and Nectria Canker, use 8 THS/gal. as growth starts in early spring.

DAHLIAS TULIPS GLADIOUS LILLES AND IRIS: For Leaf Spot and Botrytis blight (gray mold), use 6 TBB/gal. in early spring. Repeat in 7 to 10 days.

PEONY: Leaf Blotch, Botrytis blight (gray mold), use 6 THS/gal. Spray before shoots are one foot tall, repeat in two weeks. If any sign of bud blast, spray again. Remove any wilted shoots by cutting below ground. Place in paper bag and burn. Remove old stalks and leaves in fall and burn - do not compest.

DELPHINIUM GERANIUM: Leaf Spots, use 4 THS/gal. at first sign of disease.

PALIS: Anthracnose, Scab, Leaf Spot, use 6 THS/gal. Spray at first sign of disease.
