Acme Ant Roach Blaster, containing Ronnel as the active ingredient, is a new highly effective insecticide for control of certain pests in the home. It is packed in a simple self-applying package for economical and effective use. Does not stain linoleum or painted surfaces. No unpleasant odor.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Remove cap and squeeze side walls of can to produce a fine stream. Hold nozzle side of can down so liquid covers this opening. Plastic insert may be removed and contents used in a regular sprayer giving a coarse spray. Not a space spray. Will not mix with water.

For control of Ants, Roaches, and Waterbugs spray in cracks and crevices, along baseboards and around water pipes and other areas frequented by these pests. Usually a single treatment will give control for 4 to 6 weeks. Repeat as necessary to maintain control. Spiders are killed by direct contact, residual effects are not known. For control of fleas in animal sleeping quarters, use contents in a regular sprayer; make thorough application. Renew bedding. Do not treat animals. Avoid application of areas frequented by children.

CAUTION: IRRITANT TO SKIN AND EYES

Irritating to the skin and eyes. Do not use in the eyes. Avoid repeated contact with the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mists. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid contamination of food, feedstuffs, and water supplies. Keep material out of reach of children and animals. Do not apply to cats or birds. Combustible liquid-keep away from heat and open flame. Keep container closed when not in use. Note to Physician: This material is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote.
