The labeling, referred to above, submitted in connection with the application under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the following change:

1. Under "Use Precautions";

> It is recommended that you add the following spray drift precautionary statements: "Do not allow spray to drift from the application site and contact people, structures people occupy at any time and the associated property, parks and recreation areas, nontarget crops, aquatic and wetland areas, woodlands, pastures, rangelands, or animals. Apply only when wind speed is not more than 10 mph. For sprays, apply largest size droplets possible."

2. Under "Storage and Disposal";

Change "Storage" to "Pesticide Storage."

The amended label supersedes all previously accepted labels. A stamped copy of the revised label is enclosed for your records. Please submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.



- 1. Mix ¾ to 1 pint per gallon of water in sprayer or sprinkler applicator. Apply one gallon of spray mixture per 100 square feet.
- If sprayer is used, work at lowest possible pressure and use large nozzle orifices to give large droplets. On scattered weeds wet all foliage to the soil. Full wetting is essential for good control. New shoots from deep rooted perennials such as Canada thistle and milkweed may require retreatments.
- 3. Make application when weeds are young and actively growing. Action is slow if soil is dry or plants wilted.
- 4. Apply along fence lines, gravel drives, patio blocks, and around buildings where no growth or complete control is desired. Kills grass and broadleaf weeds. Do not use on lawns. Some species such as oxalis may not be completely killed. Annual weeds may sprout from seed 3 to 4 months following treatment. Tall weeds should be cut first as the dead foliage is a fire hazard.
- 5. Activity is apparent on plants in a few days but root absorption may take 2 or 3 weeks. The spray mixture is white and any skips are noticeable so that complete coverage is easy to obtain.
