

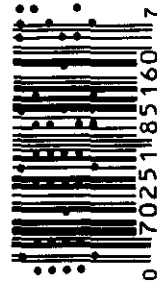

USE PRECAUTIONS

Care must be taken that none of this herbicide falls on flower beds or edges of lawns. Do not spray roots of desirable trees, shrubs or grape vines. Never use a weed killer sprayer or equipment to apply insecticides or fungicides. Do not use same spray equipment to apply insecticides or fungicides. Do not use same spray equipment for other purposes. Avoid spray drift to vegetables, flowers, ornamentals or other desirable plants. Do not use fine mist sprays. 1. Mix ¾ to 1 pint of Gordon's® Vegetation Killer per gallon of water in sprayer or sprinkler applicator. If sprayer is used, work at lowest possible pressure and use large nozzle orifices to give large droplets.
2. Apply one (1) gallon of spray mixture per 100 square feet. On scattered weeds wet all foliage to the ground. Full wetting is essential for good control. New shoots from deep-rooted perennials such as Canada thistle and milkweed may require repeat spraying.

3. Make application when weeds are young and actively growing. Action is slow if ground is dry or plants wilted.
4. Apply along fence lines, gravel drives, patio blocks, and around buildings where no growth is desired. Kills grass and broadleaf weeds. Do not use on lawns. Some species such as oxalis may not be completely killed. Annual weeds may sprout from seed 3 to 4 months following treatment. Tall weeds should be cut first as the dead foliage is a fire hazard.
5. Activity is apparent on plants in a few days but kill by root absorption may take 2 or 3 weeks. The spray mixture is white and any skips are noticeable so that complete coverage is easy to obtain.

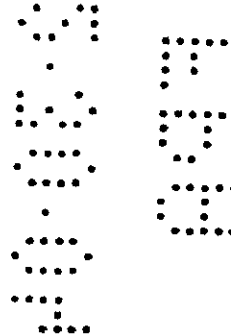
