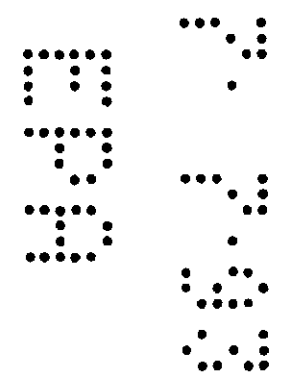

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep from freezing. Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children or pets. Do not store near food or feedstuffs. To prevent cross-contamination, do not store near fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides, or near seeds.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspapers and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

A highly refined miscible oil for winter control of certain insects. Apply in dormant period before buds open - late winter or early spring. Do not apply when spray will freeze to limbs as injury may result from the excess deposit. Remove all loose bark prior to spraying. Scales may be protected by these "shingles". Spray to wet all twigs, limbs, and the trunk. Measure dosage to be used carefully. Add to water, and mix thoroughly. Do not use mixture after standing without stirring.

APPLES, PEARS, PEACHES, CHERRIES, PLUMS, GRAPES: Use 1/2 cupful (4 fluid ounces) of product to 1 gallon of water (1-1/2 gallons to 50 gallons) to control European Red Mite eggs, certain aphids and scale insects.

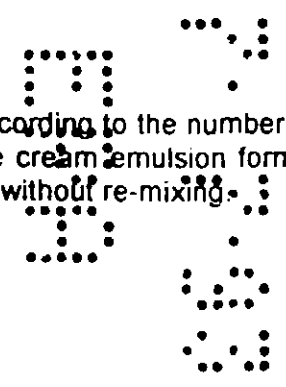
OAKS, ELM, WILLOWS, BASSWOOD (Linden): Use 1/2 cupful (4 fluid ounces) of product to 1 gallon of water (1-1/2 gallons to 50 gallons). Do not use on Maples, Mountain Ash (Sorbus) and Beech.

LILAC, ROSES, FLOWERING QUINCE, COTONEASTER, HAWTHORN: Mix 1 cupful (8 fluid ounces) in 3 gallons of water (1 gallon to 50 gallons).

EVERGREENS: Fir, Spruce, Pine, Yews and Arborvitae are quite sensitive to oils. Blue Spruce may be discolored. Be extremely careful not to overspray. Use 1 cupful (8 fluid ounces) of product in 3 gallons of water. Do not exceed this dosage. Apply as a fine mist just before new spring growth starts. Do not use on broadleaf evergreens.

- HOSE END SPRAYERS -

To use in hose-end sprayers, measure the required amount of oil into the jar according to the number of gallons of spray to be used. Fill jar to proper mark with water. Stir until white cream emulsion forms. Attach to sprayer head and apply. Do not use after standing over a few minutes without re-mixing.
