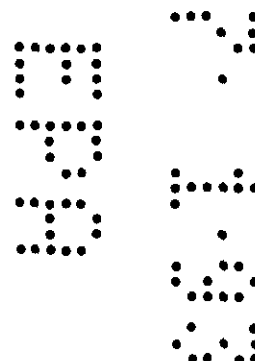

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Discard in trash.

USE ONLY WHEN WEARING THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE CLOTHING:

Wear long-sleeved shirt and long-legged pants and chemical resistant gloves.

IMPORTANT! If the pesticide comes in contact with skin wash off with soap and water. Always wash hands, face, and arms with soap and water before smoking, eating, drinking, or toileting.

AFTER USE: Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water. Take off all work clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Do not reuse contaminated clothing. Clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles.

HOW TO USE:

Measure area to be treated. The contents of this package is enough for 1000 sq. ft. Suspend the powder in enough water to be able to cover the area evenly. Shake sprayer to prevent settling. For smaller areas, use 3 tbs. per 250 sq. ft. This powder compacts on standing. Shake container prior to measuring. Do not use sprayer that has been used for 2,4-D. Clean equipment thoroughly after use.

TURF: To prevent Crabgrass, Annual Bluegrass, and Spotted Spurge, apply in early spring when forsythia is in bloom. Annual bluegrass may be treated in August prior to fall rains. Do not try to reseed bare areas for at least 60 days. Do not use on bentgrass. Chewings fescue may be thinned by this treatment. Do not allow children or pets to play on treated area until area has been sprinkled and surface has dried.

SHRUBS, FLOWER BEDS: Soil must be clean and freshly cultivated. The preventive effect is on weed seeds as they sprout. Use only on established shrubs and flowers or transplants. Do not use on Bugleweed, Button Pink, Pink or Carnation (Dianthus), Geum, Germander, Mesembryanthemum, Pansy, Phlox, Sweet William, or Telanthera.

STRAWBERRIES: New plantings maybe treated as soon as plants are set. Established beds should be clean cultivated. Apply in fall and early spring. Do not apply after first bloom.

VEGETABLES: Treat cabbage, cauliflower, broccoli, onions, snapbeans, potatoes, and garlic as soon as seeded or transplanted. Delay treating cucumber, squash, melons, and tomatoes 4 to 6 weeks after seeding or transplanting. Lettuce, leaf and head – make one treatment only no later than 3 weeks after crop is up. Sweet potatoes, yams, eggplants, and peppers – treat as soon as transplanted. If delayed, clean and cultivate prior to application. Established weeds are not controlled.

Apply to any area as uniformly as possible. Untreated or skipped areas will show weeds.

The following common annual weeds are controlled as the seeds sprout: Annual Bluegrass, Barnyardgrass, Browntop and Fall Panicum, Common Chickweed, Hairy and Smooth Crabgrass, Goosegrass, Green and Yellow Foxtail, Witchgrass, Texas millet, Lovegrass, Carpetweed, Lambsquarters, Palmer Amaranth, Spiny and Redroot pigweed, Purslane, Prostrate and Spotted Spurge, and Wright Ground Cherry.
