

LAWN RENOVATION: If nimblewill or other undesirable grasses such as Bermuda have taken over patches of turf, spray in August or early September to kill these grasses. If any area is still green after 5 days repeat at the same dosage. When foliage is all brown (5 days) rake out dead grass, scarify the soil surface, water thoroughly and seed as a new lawn. Keep area watered. Fertilize lightly as soon as grass seedlings are 2" high.

For killing weeds and grasses along driveways, drainage ditch banks, fence rows, walls and large well-established trees use one pint Acme Weed Killer per gallon of water.
