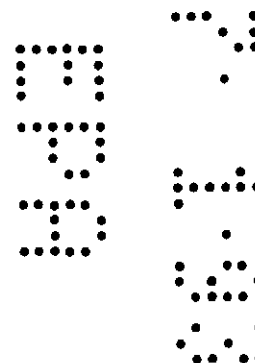

#### **Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals**

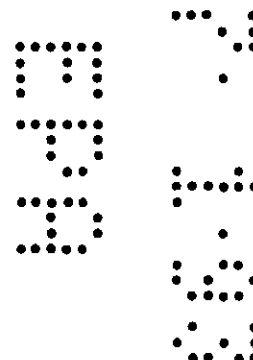
**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** When container is empty, rinse with water at least twice. Add this water as part of tank dilution. Punch holes in top and bottom so container cannot be reused. Discard in safe place or bury.

#### **Use Precautions**

Acme Weed Killer is non-selective. Careless use may cause injury to desirable plants. Do not spray or allow to drift onto foliage, green bark, graft unions, or tree wounds, or contact flowers or lawns.

Do not track from treated area onto turf. Damaged grass may be raked out and reseeded after 14 days. Keep area watered after seeding.



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**LAWN RENOVATION:** If nimblewill or other undesirable grasses such as Bermuda have taken over patches of turf, spray in August or early September to kill these grasses. Mow area to be treated close - 1" high. Apply 1 quart of weed and grass killer per 800 square feet in enough water to wet foliage completely. If any area is still green after 5 days repeat at the same dosage. When foliage is all brown (5 days) rake out dead grass, scarify the soil surface, water thoroughly and seed as a new lawn. Keep area watered. Fertilize lightly as soon as grass seedlings are 2" high.

For killing weeds and grasses along driveways, drainage ditch banks, fence rows, walls and large well-established trees use one pint Acme Weed Killer per gallon of water. Contains wetting agent for better foliage contact. Apply using a sprayer or plastic sprinkler can. Do not allow spray to stand in galvanized equipment. Wash sprayer and other utensils after use. Apply spray over entire foliage to be killed. To avoid foam, fill sprayer to mark with water and add weed and grass killer last. Mix by stirring or swirling.

For best results treat weeds while they are young and actively growing. Woody plants and deep-rooted perennials should be resprayed as soon as any regrowth shows. Dense, tall weed stands should be checked in 3 to 5 days and any skips be sprayed. Depending on density of vegetation, one gallon of spray should cover approximately 150 square feet. Do not overspray as material that falls on the ground is not active. Two light applications just to the runoff point is more effective than one heavy spraying.
