Dear Dr. Armbruster:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. Delete the heading "ANTIDOTE FOR ARSENIC" and the entire paragraph immediately following this heading.

b. In the "APPENDIX" section, delete the claims "Works in hours" and "Fast acting". These claims conflict with the statement "If green tissue remains at five days after application..." in the "LAWN RENOVATION" section.

2. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration may be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Do not allow children or pets on treated areas. Do not allow domestic animals to graze treated areas.

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF-SWALLOWED: Call a physician immediately. Drink 1 or 2-glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching-back of threat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Then give two tablespoonfuls of Epsom Salts or Milk of Magnesia in water and plenty of milk and water. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. Do not give fluids to an unconscious person.

Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not store near feed or food products.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: When-container is empty, rinse with water at least twice, Add this water as part of tank dilution. Punch holes in tep-and bottom so container cannot be reused. Discard in-safe place or bury. Non-aerosol products (bottles, cans, jars) - Do not reuse container (bottle, can, jar). Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

USE PRECAUTIONS:

Acme Weed Killer is non-selective herbicide and will kill weeds and grasses on contact. Do not spray or allow contact with leaves, stems, bark, graft unions, or wounds of trees and ornamentals. Do not spray or allow contact with the leaves and stems of flowers and desirable plants.

- · Do not track from treated area of turfgrass onto the untreated area.
- Do not sprinkle the treated area immediately after application.
- Rinse equipment thoroughly after use.

LAWN RENOVATION:

To destroy weedy sections of lawns and turfgrass, apply Acme Weed Killer during the growing season, Sun and high temperatures increase the rate of activity. Mow the lawn to about a one (1) inch height before treatment

Mix 32 fluid ounces of Acme Weed Killer in 3.0 gallons of water and apply to 800 sg. ft. of turfgrass. Spray grass blades thoroughly. If green tissue remains at five days after application, then reapply at the same dosage. Bermudagrass, nimblewill, and deep rooted perennials may require a second treatment at the same dosage rate in five (5) days.

When the leaves are brown, the treated areas should be raked to remove the dead vegetation. Seeding, sodding, or springing may be done at 14 days after application, and the lawn can be re-established according to local practices.

TRIM AND EDGING TREATMENTS:

Acme Weed Killer can be used for trimming and edging to control weeds along sidewalks, patios, fences, trees, walls, fence posts, signposts, and driveways. This product does not provide residual weed control and additional applications may be needed.

Apply using a hand-operated sprayers (plunger or pump-up sprayers).

Mix sixteen (16) fluid ounces of Acme Weed Killer with one (1.0) gallon of water and apply to 150 sg. ft. of turfgrass. Acme Weed Killer contains a wetting agent for improved weed control. Mix thoroughly before application. Apply at the proper rate in the proper amount of water to the measured area.

For the best results, apply when the weeds are young and actively growing. Bermudagrass, nimblewill, woody plants, and deep rooted perennials may require a second treatment at the same dosage rate in five (5) days.

SPOT TREATMENTS:

Mix Acme Weed Killer with water to spot treat unwanted vegetation in areas such as along patios, driveways, sidewalks, fences, walls, around established trees and signposts.

Spray thoroughly unwanted vegetation. The best kill is obtained on young plants and during hot sunny weather.

Mix 10 - 14 fl. oz. of Acme Weed Killer in one (1,0) gallon of water. Or, follow the recommendations for soray preparation below. Use the higher concentration to control bermudagrass, nimblewill, woody plants, and deep rooted perennials.

Apply using a trigger spraver or hand-operated spravers (plunger or pump-up spravers). Repeat applications may be necessary.

HELPFUL USE TIPS:

- 1. Thorough spray coverage of all plants is required.
- 2. Retreatment may be necessary if rainfall or irrigation occurs within 12 hours of application.
- 3. To avoid foam, first fill the sprayer with water and then add this product.
- 4. Do not allow spray to stand in galvanized equipment.

USE PRECAUTIONS:

Acme Weed Killer is non-selective. Careless use may cause injury to desirable plants. Do not spray or allow to drift onto-foliage, green bark, graft unions, or tree wounds, or contact flowers or lawns.

Do-not-track-from-treated-area-onto-turf. Damaged-grass-may be-raked out and reseeded-after-14 days. Keep area watered after seeding.

LAWN-RENOVATION: If nimblewill or other undesirable grasses such as Bermuda have taken over patches of turf, spray in August or early September to kill these grasses. Mow area to be treated close -1" high. Apply 1-quart of weed and grass killer per 800 square-feet in enough water to wet foliage completely. If any area is still green after 5 days repeat at the same dosage. When foliago is all brown (5-days) rake out dead grass, scarify the soil surface, water thoroughly and seed as a new lawn. Keep area watered. Fertilize lightly as soon as grass seedlings are 2" high.

For killing-weeds-and-grasses-along-driveways, drainage-ditchbanks, fence-rows, walls-and-large well-established-trees use-one-pint-Acme-Weed-Killer per gallon of water. -Contains-wetting-agent for better foliage contact. Apply-using-a-sprayer or plastic sprinkler can. Do not allow-spray to-stand in galvanized--squipment.--Wash-sprayer and other utensils after use. Apply-spray-over-entire foliage to be-killed.--To-avoid-foam, fill-sprayer to mark with water and add weed-and-grass-killer last.-- Mix by stirring-or-swirling.-

For best results treat weeds while they are young and actively growing. Woody plants and deep rooted perennials should be resprayed as soon as any regrowth shows. Dense, tall weed stands should be checked in 3 to 5 days and any skips be sprayed. Depending on density of vegetation, one gallon of spray should cover approximately 150 square feet. Do not overspray as material that falls on the ground is not active. Two light applications just to the runoff point is more effective than one heavy spraying.
