Use 5 lbs./gal. water. Spray until all foliage is wet. Repeat at 5 day intervals to protect new foliage. Note reduced dosage for use on cucumbers and melons to avoid injury. Do not use teaspoons or tablespoons or other utensils for other purposes once used with pesticides. Note the time intervals to stop use before harvest. Subsequent planting of food and feed crops in treated soil must be made with crops on this or other carbaryl (Sevin) label(s).
