DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read cautions and directions carefully.

EVERGREENS AND SHADE TREES: Use 3 1/2 TB. per gallon of water in late May or early June as soon as first small bags appear. Spray all leaves or needles thoroughly. Repeat if necessary. Treat arbor vitae, junipers and spruce, as well as broadleafed shade trees. For tent caterpillars, catalpa sphinx, cankworms and fall webworms, use 5 1/2 TB. per gallon. Miticide controls red spiders. Do not spray on bearing fruit trees. May be used on ornamental crab apples.

PRIVET WEEDS: Spray for mite and thrip control.

SPRAYS: Use 3 1/2 TB. per gallon to control red spiders, grasshoppers, cutworms, trips and army worms on gladiolus and chrysanthemums. Repeat as necessary for control. Some flowers may be injured. Do not make a general spraying without first testing on a few leaves and flowers.

BAITS: For grub worms, use 3 1/2 TB. per gallon per 500 sq. ft. Sprinkle after spraying to get spray into soil. For chiggers, let spray dry on the grass. Repeat in 2 to 3 weeks or as needed for control. Keep children and pets off treated areas until after watering and the turf has dried completely.

CAUTION: May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not breathe spray mist. Wash with soap and water after using. Keep out of reach of children.

Toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not contaminate streams, lakes or ponds with this material. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Do not use other than as specified on this label. Destroy container when empty. Do not reuse.
