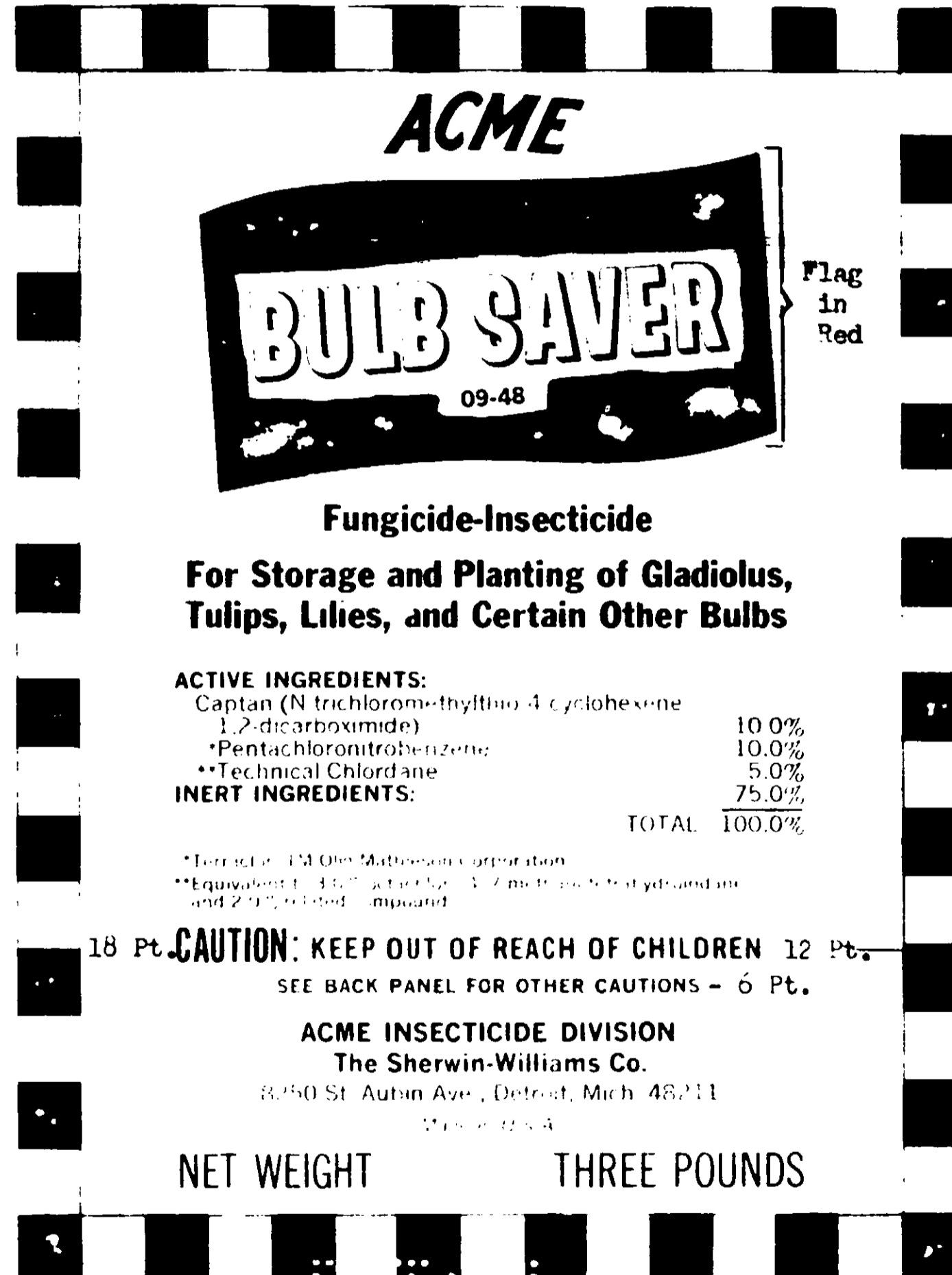

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read all cautions and directions carefully.

**STORAGE:** This treatment is to control thrips and spread of storage rots from infected or damaged bulbs. Dig or harvest bulbs, corms or rhizomes in the usual manner. After curing, remove loose dirt and dead foliage. Place a layer of Bulb Saver in a carton or tray lined with newspaper. Space bulbs so they do not touch. Cover with a layer of Bulb Saver. Store in a cool (40°F) dry place.

**WHEN PLANTING:** After opening a furrow or holes, sprinkle Bulb Saver in the bottom. Place the bulb and sprinkle Bulb Saver over before replacing dirt, then sprinkle over soil surface after dirt is replaced. This aids in root disease control and aids in control of Cutworms, Sowbugs, and Wireworms. Follow your usual summer insect and fungus control program. It is considered good practice not to plant bulbs in the same location year after year.

The product is of benefit in controlling tulip fire, crown and root rots of tulip, root and collar rot of gladiolus, crocus and freesia, aztec and calla lilies and canna. Tuberos begonia crown and root rot, also apply to soil surface after covering. Work into soil prior to planting. It is also used for control of sclerotium rot, also when separating tub. to prevent crown rot.

**NOTE:** To be effective, product contains dust. One pound should treat 25 feet of furrow and adjacent soil.

**CAUTION:** Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contact with the skin, may be irritating. Wash thoroughly after using. Use rubber gloves if sprinkling by hand. Avoid contamination of food or foodstuffs.
