BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS IN BUILDINGS: Dust infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, under the edges of rugs and floor coverings, between and under cushions of upholstered furniture and other places where these pests may hide. Old bedding of pets should be removed after treatment of pet area and replaced with clean fresh bedding. Additionally, ensure that pets are treated with an EPA approved product registered for pet use.

Make a residual treatment around windows and doors, porches, screens, eaves, patios, garages, under stairways and in crawl spaces and other areas where pests hide.

To help prevent invasion of buildings and structures by the above pests, treat a band of soil and vegetation 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the building foundation and crawl spaces where pests are active and may find entrance. Apply thoroughly and uniformly to the band area. Pay particular attention to ant hills and wasp nests in the band area. Wasp nests in trees and shrubs may be treated as noted above.

<u>FIRE ANTS</u>: Stir 7 oz. into 2 gallons of water. Pour a small amount of material around the perimeter of the mound. Apply the remaining volume directly on the mound so as to penetrate insect galleries, using 2 gallons of mixture on mounds 8 inches or larger in diameter. Less mixture can be used on smaller mounds; however, thorough penetration of the insect galleries must be achieved. A second treatment may be necessary if complete control is not obtained.


