Please revise your "Storage and Disposal" section according to PR Notice 83-3, i.e., add the subheading "Pesticide Disposal (bold type)" followed by the wording, "Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility." Next add the subheading "Container Disposal (bold type)" followed by the wording, "Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash."
