STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner in which it is not intended. CENTURION is a proven "one-step" disinfectant-cleaner, effective in water up to 400 ppm hardness in the presence of 1 oz./gallon. CENTURION will remove hard water deposits and lime scale as directed.

Apply Use-Dilution to porcelain and ceramic tiles, bathtubs, shower bowl surfaces, related fixtures and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces. Use a brush, sponge or mechanical spray device so as to thoroughly wet surfaces. Preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or weekly. Surfaces must remain wet for ten minutes.

Hard Water Disinfection — At 4 oz. per gallon use level when evaluated by the Standard Test, CENTURION is effective in the presence of 5% blood serum against:

Mold and Mildew Control — At 3.0 oz./gallon, CENTURION will control mold and mildew and the odors caused by them when applied to surfaces (as indicated in general instructions above). Allow to dry on surface and return.

***Sanitizing-Non-Food Contact Surfaces** (such as floors, walls, tables, etc.) At use level, CENTURION is an effective sanitizer against Staphylococcus pneumoniae on hard porous and non-porous environmental surfaces. Surfaces remain wet for 60 seconds.
