Sanitizing of Food Processing Equipment and Other Hard Surfaces in Food Contact Locations. For sanitizing food processing equipment, dairy processing equipment, stainless steel, aluminum, glass, and type countertop, and plastic, metal, and display equipment and other hard non-porous surfaces. No Potable water rinse is required.

Wash and rinse surfaces thoroughly, then apply a solution of ENFORCER 100210 (500ppm active). Surfaces should remain wet for at least 10 minutes, followed by adequate draining and air drying. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty. For manual application, use solution may not be reused for sanitizing applications.

Apply to stainless steel, countertops, refrigerated storage and display equipment and other stationary hard surfaces by cloth or brush or mechanical spray device. No Potable water rinse is required.

Dishes, silverware, glasses, cooking utensils and other similar food processing equipment can be sanitized by immersion in a 1000 ppm solution of ENFORCER 100210. No Potable water rinse is required.

All 100 gallons of ENFORCER 100210 meets the criteria of Appendix F of the Code of Federal Regulations, 1978 Recommendations of the U.S. Public Health Service in waters up to 800 ppm of hardness calculated as CaCO₃, when evaluated by the AOAC Germicidal and Detergent Sanitizer Method against *Escherichia coli* and *Staphylococcus aureus*.

The udders, teats and teats of dairy cows can be sanitized by washing with a solution of ENFORCER 100210 in gallons of warm water. No Potable water rinse is required. Use a fresh towel for each cow. Avoid contamination of sanitizing solution by dirt and soil. Do not dip used towel back into sanitizing solution. When solution becomes visibly dirty, discard and provide fresh solution.
