# **Directions for Use**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply Bear-Cat Distribution with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device. When applied with a mechanical spray device, surface must be sprayed until thoroughly wetted. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when the use solution becomes visibly dirty.

Disinfection of Animal Facilities and Equipment. 
