

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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS

DANGER

Corrosive, may cause severe skin irritation or chemical burns to broken skin. Causes eye damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash after handling. Avoid breathing vapors. Vacate poorly ventilated areas as soon as possible. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Treated effluent may not be discharged into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters without a valid discharge permit. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT: Mix only with water according to label directions. Mixing this product with gross filth such as feces, urine, etc., or with ammonia, acids, detergents or other chemicals may release hazardous gases irritating to eyes, lungs and mucous membranes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or discard by placing in trash collection or burying in an approved landfill. Product or residue that cannot be used, should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.

FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS SANITIZATION

CANNING PLANTS: Sanitize after cleaning by spraying tanks, vats and other open processing equipment, or circulate a sanitizing solution through pipelines and enclosed equipment using Solution F (200 ppm). All surfaces should be exposed to the sanitizing solution for a period of two minutes. Three ppm (Solution B) should be maintained in the cooling canal water.

MEAT PACKING PLANTS: Cutting room floors, tables and cutting and trimming tools should be cleaned and then sanitized with Solution F (200 ppm). Cooling room freezers should be fogged with Solution F (200 ppm). Bacon slicing equipment, conveyors for punch viscera, etc., metal or non-porous surfaces should be cleaned and then sanitized with Solution F (200 ppm). An exposure time of not less than two minutes should be allowed.
