The Confidential Statement of Formula dated June 16, 1988 is acceptable and a copy has been inserted in your file for this product.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Revise the Formulator's Instructions to read:

Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their formulated products which may be labeled for the use pattern(s) as found listed on this label.

2. Add the following paragraph to the label:

This product may be used for formulation only into end-use products for use in the following "Use Patterns":

Terrestrial Food Uses On

Cotton and Soybeans

3. The Statement of Practical Treatment should read as follows:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- If Swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Vomiting should be supervised by a physician because of the possible pulmonary damage via aspiration of the solvent. If possible, bring this container and labeling to the attending physician. For emergency assistance, call (201) 231-2000.
- If Inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- If On Skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If In Eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

In addition, the Statement of Practical Treatment is normally required on the front panel.

4. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement to read as follows:


