This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA Section 3(c)(7)(B), since you agreed to:

1. Conduct (repeat) the trialomethrin fish life-cycle study (Guideline Reference No. 72-5) through completion and submit a final report of this study in accordance with the approved protocol dated December 6, 1989.
2. Submit a progress report by August 21, 1990 and submit the final study by April 1, 1991.

The conditional registration will be subject to an expiration date of September 1, 1990. This expiration will occur automatically notwithstanding the fulfillment of any conditions of registration. It is further agreed that the registrant will not have the right to continue to use the product under this conditional registration for this period of time to allow the Agency review of the ~~negotiated~~ study submitted and reviewed in October 1989. It is concluded that continued use of trialomethrin for this short period of time will not cause a significant increase in the risk of adverse effects to the environment. Upon completion of review of the ~~negotiated~~ study and all other available data, the Agency will decide whether this product could be registered under FIFRA Section 3(c)(5) or if other regulatory action is warranted.

As you know the current tolerances for tralomethrin are due to expire December 1990. In the past, the Agency has often continued tolerances for one year beyond the expiration date for conditional registrations. We are not doing this now because we will be making another decision on the registration of tralomethrin in August, well before the current tolerances expire. At that time the Agency will update the tolerance status based upon our final decision regarding the registration of tralomethrin and if necessary publish a Federal Register Notice.

3. Submit product information (pounds or gallons produced) for this product for the fiscal year in which the use as a technical/manufacturing use product is conditionally registered, in accordance with FIFRA Section 29. The fiscal year begins October 1, and ends September 30.
