

PINE-OIL per gallon of water, mop, then rinse with clear water. For bath tub and shower stalls - follow above directions. Add 2 Tbsp. PINE-OIL to toilet bowl at nite. In the morning before flushing, mop surface.

WOOD FLOORS: Mop floors with a solution of 2 Tbsp. of PINE-OIL to 3 gallons of water. Use soap in solution if desired.

TILE AND CEMENT: Mop floors with 4 Tbsp. PINE-OIL to 3 gallons of water. Use soap if desired.

NOTE: Rubber or asphalt tile, rinse immediately with clear water.

Kitchen stoves, sinks, drainboards, refrigerators; for ordinary cleaning use 4 Tbsp. PINE-OIL per gallon of water. For extra heavy grease use 1/2 PINE-OIL and 1/2 water. Let soak, rinse off. Treated food contact surfaces must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergent and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

GARBA PAILS: Use 2 Tbsp. PINE-OIL tol 'ater.

DIRECTIONS

FOR LAUNDRY: (Cleaning and deodorizing): 80 % 13% Add 3/4 cup PINE-OIL per load for top loading machines, or 1/2 cup for front loading machines 7 % along with soap or detergent. When soaking diapers add 4 Tbsp. PINE-OIL per gallon of 100 % water.

> FOR STUBBORN STAINS: To remove bad stains (grease or grime) before laundering, soak stained spots in full strength PINE-OIL for a few minutes before laundering.

SOFTENS PAINT BRUSHES: Works on paint brushes, even those stiffened from oil based paints. Soak in full strength PINE-OIL a few hours or overnight. Turns stiff bristles soft.

FOR DISINFECTING

Floors and walls, shower stalls, tubs and basins, 2 ounces of PINE-OIL per gallon of water. Apply with mop or sponge.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Do not re-use empty container. Wash thoroughly with water and detergent. Discard in a safe place
