DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

FOR LAUNDRY: (Cleaning and deodorizing): Add 3/4 cup PINE-OIL per load for top loading machines, or 1/2 cup for front loading machines along with soap or detergent. When soaking carpets, add 4 Tbsp. PINE-OIL per gallon of water.

FOR STUBBORN STAINS: To remove bad stains (grout or grime) before laundering, scrub stained spots in full strength PINE-OIL for a few minutes before laundering.

SOFTENS PAINT BRUSHES: Works on paint brushes, even those stiffened from oil based paints. Soak in full strength PINE-OIL a few hours or overnight. Toss out bristles out.

FOR DISINFECTING

Remove heavy soil or gross filth, thoroughly clean surfaces prior to application of product, use 2.5 ounces per gallon of water. Apply with mop or sponge and let stand for 10 minutes. Remove solution by mop or sponge.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD, OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL.
STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not store near heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not clean equipment or dispose of equipment components in a manner that will contaminate water resources.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Metal containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities. Plastic containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incinerate, or, if allowed by State and local authorities by burning. If burned stay out of contact.

DIRECTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING

BATHROOM: For wash basins, use 4 Tbsp. PINE-OIL per gallon of water, mop, then rinse with clear water. For bathtub and shower stalls - follow above directions. Add 5 Tbsp. PINE-OIL to toilet bowl at night. In the morning before flushing, mop surface.

WOOD FLOORS: Mop floors with a solution of 2 Tbsp. PINE-OIL to 3 gallons of water, use soap if desired.

TILE AND CEMENT: Mop floors with 4 Tbsp. PINE-OIL to 3 gallons of water. Use soap if desired.

NOTE: Rubber and asphalt tile, rinse immediately with clear water. Kitchen stoves, sinks, drainboards, refrigerators, for ordinary cleaning, use 4 Tbsp. PINE-OIL per gallon of water. For extra heavy grease, use 1/2 PINE-OIL and 1/2 water. Let soak, rinse off. Treated food contact surfaces must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergent and rinsed with potable water prior to use.

GARBAGE PAIL: Use 2 Tbsp. PINE-OIL to 1 gallon water.
