POTABLE-AQUA drinking water germicidal tablets are intended for emergency disinfection of drinking water. All waters can be made bacteriologically suitable for drinking when treated with POTABLE-AQUA as directed. POTABLE-AQUA is for use by the military, emergency organizations, campers, hikers and anyone that would have an opportunity to drink water of uncertain bacteriological quality.

For use only when fresh drinking water is suspected or known to be substandard. Not to be used on a continuous basis.

**WARNING:** Tablets may be harmful if swallowed. Avoid eye contact. Will cause severe irritation to eyes and mucous membranes. Avoid contamination of food. Wash after handling. **FIRST AID:** If tablet is swallowed, drink freely a thin paste of starch or flour (2 tablespoons with water) or Sodium thiosulfate (approximately 1/2 teaspoonful in water). In case of contact with eyes, flush thoroughly with water. Call a physician. Do not reuse this bottle. Discard in a safe place.

#### DIRECTIONS

Add 1 tablet to 1 quart or liter of water. Cap loosely to allow a little leakage. Wait 3 minutes. Shake thoroughly so that a little water leaks out and rinses the screw threads. Then tighten cap. Wait 10 minutes before drinking. If water is very cold or contains rotten leaves or is dirty and discolored, use 2 tablets. Wait 20 minutes before drinking.
