 CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Soluble Oil is an emulsifiable spray oil designed for use against Spider Mites, Whiteflies and certain Scale Insects attacking Citrus. This product should be diluted in water for use as directed on this label.

NOTE

Do not use more than 1 gallon per 100 gallons of spray as injury may possibly result under certain circumstances. Do not use oil sprays on foliage within 30 days before or after using Sulfur or Captan. Do not repeat oil sprays in less than 30 days of first application, nor use more than twice in twelve month period. Do not spray trees or plants weakened from any cause whatsoever such as lack of moisture, excess moisture, cold or freeze damage, recent root pruning or transplanting.

Use contrary to these directions may cause serious plant, crop or personal injury, unsatisfactory control or other unintended consequences.

CITRUS: Against Spider mites and Whitefly, use 3 to 4 gallons per 500 gallons of spray (5 to 6 pints per 100 gallons) Apply for thorough coverage of top and bottom sides of foliage. Against Purple Scale, Florida Red Scale, Yellow Scale, Brown Soft Scale, Glover Scale, use 5 gallons per 500 gallon tank (1 gallon/100 gallons). Apply for thorough coverage of all leaves, twigs and fruit. Use when needed within the limits of the cautions
