DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read entire directions thoroughly before use. Apply by using 3 parts FLY OFF-CONCENTRATE to 7 parts water. First put required amount into mixing container, then add water. Make just enough finished product to treat animals. The dilution should not be saved and used again. Before application, brush animal to remove loose dirt, dust and debris.

To Use as a Wipe moisten (don't soak) a piece of turkish towel with FLY OFF-CONCENTRATE. Rub briskly against the direction of hair growth. Give special attention to shanks, legs, shoulders, neck and facial area. Avoid contact with eyes and nostrils. Use no more than 1 to 2 ounces on mature horses and 1/2 to 1 ounce on ponies. Do not wet the skin. For best results, apply daily.

To Use as a Spray — using a mechanical sprayer, spray animal from a distance of 1 foot. 1 to 2 ounces is sufficient to treat an adult horse. For ponies, use 1/2 to 1 ounce per animal. Apply once daily, preferably in the morning. Do not wet the hide.
