- 1. Your product and its packaging can not be modified from the descriptions given in your June 12, 1995 letter and attachments and your October 18, 1995 application form unless you submit an amendment application and receive EPA approval.
2. The source of your technical grade of active ingredient can not be modified from the description given in your July 14, 1995 Confidential Statement of Formula unless you submit an amendment application and receive EPA approval.
3. Your product labeling must 1) have the "If Injested" section of the Statement of Practical Treatment deleted; 2) have the Precautionary Statements replaced with "Caution: Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Avoid skin and eye contact with the evaporation hole. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid inhalation."; 3) have "EPA Reg. No. 34473-xx replaced with EPA Reg. No. 34473-4"; 4) have "SEE BACK PANEL FOR ADDITONAL WARNINGS" replaced with "SEE BACK PANEL FOR ADDITONAL PRECAUTIONS"and 5) have "or refrigerate" deleted from the Storage section before shipment.



MOSQUITO ATTRACTANT

**THIS PRODUCT IS INTENDED FOR USE
WITH ELECTRONIC INSECT KILLERS**

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Open attractant carton, remove aluminum strip and bend into "U" shape along scored lines (see Illustration A).

Remove sealed attractant container from carton and peel off adhesive tab covering evaporation hole. Place attractant container inside the "U" of the aluminum strip with evaporation hole facing up. Slide the aluminum "U" into the bulb retainer so that the ends of the aluminum strip protrude through the slots of the bulb retainer (see Illustration B).

The ends of the aluminum strip should be on either side of the bulb. It is not necessary that they contact the bulb itself. When your insect killer is operating, the heat from the bulb will cause the proper amount of attractant to be released from the attractant container.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: **Storage:** Store unopened attractant container in a cool, dry place or refrigerate until ready to use. **Disposal:** Do not reuse attractant container. Wrap attractant container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: **Caution:** Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid skin and eye contact. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid inhaling.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: **IF INJECTED** — dilute with water and immediately induce vomiting. Do not give fluids or induce vomiting if the victim is unconscious. Get immediate medical attention. **IF INHALED** — move to fresh air. Aid in breathing, if necessary, and get immediate medical attention. **IF ON SKIN** — remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. **IF IN EYES** — flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation develops.

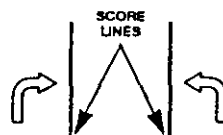

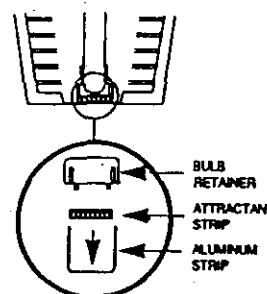
