Subject: Proposed Label Modifications Depicting a Plastic

Carrier to Hold the Attractant Cartridge in Place

Flowtron® Octenol Mosquito Attractant

EPA Registration No. 34473-4

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that the phrase "FOR USE WITH ELECTRONIC INSECT KILLERS" is replaced with "FOR USE WITH SEARS ELECTRONIC INSECT KILLERS" to specify those electronic insect killers that are compatible with this product.

While this letter approves the modified labeling and replacement of the aluminum clip with the plastic carrier no modifications to the attractant cartridge are allowed.

Submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling prior to releasing the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA § 6(e). Your release for shipment of the amended product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.



MOSQUITO ATTRACTANT


DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove sealed attractant cartridge from carton and peel off adhesive label covering evaporation holes. (See figure 1).

Place cartridge inside the "U" of the plastic carrier with the evaporation holes facing up. Slide the plastic carrier into the bulb retainer so that the ends of the carrier protrude through the slots of the bulb retainer. (See figure 2).

To remove the attractant cartridge, press ONE plastic carrier support arm towards the center and pull down. This will rotate the carrier out of the bulb retainer.

When your insect killer is operating, it will produce the required heat and convective air flow to vaporize the attractant and disperse it at the proper rate per hour.



STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Storage: Store unopened attracture certridge in a cool, dry place until ready to use.
Disposal: Do not reuse attractant cartridge. Wrap attractant cartridge in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CAUTION: Harmful it swallowed, absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Avoid skin and eye contact with the evaporation holes. Wash thoroughly with ecap and water after handling. Avoid inhalation.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: IF INHALED — move to fresh air. IF ON SKIN — wash affected areas with scop and water. IF IN EYES — flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if initiation develops.
