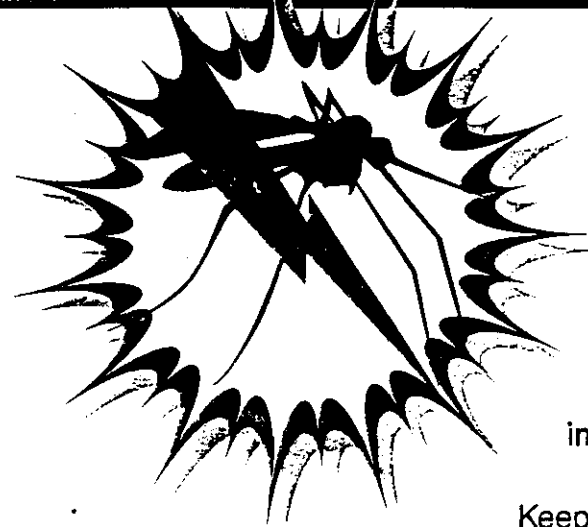

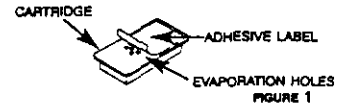
FIRST AID	
If on skin or clothing:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take off contaminated clothing. • Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If in eyes:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. • Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If inhaled:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move person to fresh air. • If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. • Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
If swallowed:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. • Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. • Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. • Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

Directions for Use:

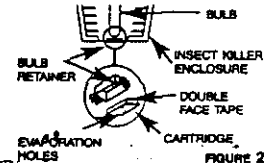
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove sealed attractant cartridge from package and peel off adhesive label covering evaporation holes. (See figure 1).



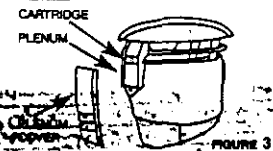
For Electronic Insect Killers:

- 1 Remove double faced tape from package and peel off backing paper from one side of tape. Press tape to bottom of cartridge. (Side opposite evaporation holes).
- 2 Peel off backing paper from opposite side of tape. Press cartridge firmly into bulb retainer at bottom of enclosure. (See figure 2).



For Mosquito PowerTrap™ Models:

- 1 Discard double-face tape (not required with PowerTrap models).
- 2 Loosen thumb-screw on plenum cover and remove cover. Place cartridge with holes facing out into the rectangle opening in the center of the plenum. Replace cover and tighten thumb-screw. (See figure 3).



When your device is operating, it will produce the required heat and convective air flow to vaporize the attractant and disperse it at the proper rate per hour.

For best results replace cartridge after 450 hours of insect killer or Mosquito PowerTrap™ use.

Storage and Disposal:

Storage: Store unopened attractant cartridge in a cool, dry place until ready to use.

Disposal: If empty: Do not reuse cartridge. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Contact your local solid waste agency at www.cleanup.org or call 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
