3. By 2/1/98, you must submit data on the release rate of octenol from your 150 mg product over 30 days and efficacy data supporting the removal of the qualifying word "certain.". If the Agency determines that the release rate and efficacy data do not support your claims, you must modify the claims on your label as directed by the Agency by 8/1/98.

4. Your one page confidential statement of formula (CSF) dated 7/29/97 is the basic and only CSF for this product. Submit a revised CSF with blocks A & B completely filled out by 9/1/97.

5. Submit five (5) copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

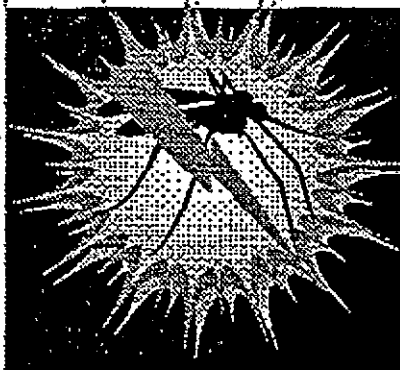

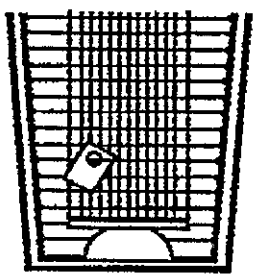

The enclosed slow-release strip is designed to continuously release OCTENOL (1-OCTEN-3-OL) a natural insect attractant, to lure mosquitoes and biting flies to your electronic insect killer.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove slow-release strip from its protective pouch. Attach strip to outer enclosure by placing oval cut-out around enclosure strut as shown.



Each strip is designed to release attractant for up to 30 days.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Avoid skin, mouth and eye contact. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.
