For rapid control of roaches, ants, spiders, crickets, silverfish, centipedes, cheese mites. meal worms, grain beetles, (confused flour beetles, red flour bettles) and weevils (granary weevils, rice weevils): Apply in a good sprayer adjusted to deliver a coarse wet spray, at a rate of 1 gallon to 750 square feet of surface.
