DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

RECIRCULATING COOLING WATER SYSTEMS

NOTE: Add this product separately to the system. Do NOT mix it with other additives in order to avoid decomposition of this product due to the high pH of many additive formulations. This product aids in the control of bacterial, atgal and fungal slimes in evaporative condensers, heat exchange water systems, commercial and industrial cooling towers, influent systems such as flow through filters and lagoons, industrial water scrubbing systems and brewery pasteurizers. Add this product to the system at any point to insure uniform mixing. This product may be added to the system either continuously or intermittently or as needed. The frequency of feeding and duration of the treatment will depend upon the severity of contamination. Optimum performance with this product is attained by continuous or intermittent treatment. INTERMITTENT OR SLUG METHOD - INITIAL DOSE: When the system is noticeably fouled, add this product at the rate of 0.18 to 0.36 lb. (21 to 43 ppm) per 1000 gallons of water in the system. Repeat until control is achieved, SUBSEQUENT DOSE: When microbial control is evident, add this product at the rate of 0.09 to 0.36 lb. (10 to 43 ppm) per 1000 gallons of water in the system every 4 days as needed to maintain control.

CONTINUOUS FEED METHOD - INITIAL DOSE: When the system is noticeably fouled, add this product at the rate of 0.18 to 0.36 lb. (21 to 43 ppm) per 1000 gallons of water in the system. SUBSEQUENT DOSE: Continuously feed this product to maintain a dosage of 0.018 to 0.18 lb. (2.1 to 21 ppm) per 1000 gallons of blowdown (or water loss) from the system.

FOR CONTROL OF FUNGI AND ALGAE: Add this product at the rate of 1.11 to 3.65 lbs. (133 to 438 ppm) per 1000 gallons of water in the system, depending upon the severity of contamination.

INTERMITTENT OR SLUG METHOD - INITIAL DOSE: When the system is noticeably fouled, add this product at the rate of 1.84 to 3.65 lbs. (221 to 438 ppm) per 1000 gallons of water in the system. Repeat until control is achieved. SUBSEQUENT DOSE: When algal control is evident, add this product at the rate of 1.11 to 3.65 lbs. (133 to 438 ppm) per 1000 gallons of water daily or as needed to maintain control.

CONTINUOUS FEED METHOD - INITIAL DOSE: When the system is noticeably fouled, add this product at the rate of 1.84 to 3.65 lbs. (221 to 438 ppm) per 1000 gallons of water in the system. Repeat until control is achieved. SUBSEQUENT DOSE: Continuously feed this product to maintain a dosage of 1.11 to 3.65 lbs. (133 to 438 ppm) per 1000 gallons of blowdown (or water loss) from the system.
