Intercide TJP is a specially prepared organotin compound for controlling gram-positive bacteria and fungi in tile grouts and wet mixed tape joint compounds.

Application Information

- 1) Will not cause sulfide staining over nail heads.
- 2) Non-deliquescent (up to 90% relative humidity).
- 3) Will not adversely affect other properties of dry powdered compound in the dry mix or wet state.

Tile Grouts

To control fungal and gram-positive bacteria in polyvinyl acetate tile grout, Intercide TJP is suggested in the range of 0.5-2.0 percent by weight.

Tape Joint Cements

To control gram-positive bacteria, Intercide TJP is suggested in the range of 0.5-2.0 percent by weight and to control bacterial growth, Intercide TJP is suggested in the range of 4.0-6.0 percent by weight for polyvinyl acetate tape joint cements.

Toxicity

The results of intensive testing by Wells Laboratories, Inc., gave an LD₅₀ of 2600 mg/kg. A copy of the complete test by Wells Laboratories, Inc. can be obtained on request.

Handling Precautions

Do not ingest. Do not get in eye, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe dust.

Handling Precautions (Cont.)

Causes severe eye damage. Wear goggles or face shield when handling. Causes skin irritation. In case of skin contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with soap and water. Standard Containers

Intercide TJP is available in fiber drums of 250 pounds net and 125 pounds net.
