COMPOSITION AND APPLICATION

Intercide ABF-5 DIDP is a formulation of 10,10'-oxybisphenoxarsine specifically designed for compatibility with flexible vinyl systems. It contains diisodecyl phthalate as its carrier.

The incorporation of approximately 0.6% by weight of an Intericide ABF-5 DIDP based on the weight of the total vinyl system, will usually provide protection against the surface growth of many mildew organisms. It is recommended that each formulation be checked out in a qualified laboratory in order to determine the optimum level required for protection. Interstab Chemicals can provide antifungal testing and/or assistance in formulation to meet individual requirements. It may be necessary to incorporate levels as high as 1.0% of this material in a vinyl system which is exposed to outside weathering.

Intericide ABF-5 DIDP contains the 10,10'-oxybisphenoxarsine in a formulation containing a primary plasticizer and can be substituted directly for the equivalent amount of plasticizer it is replacing.
