DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Sinesto B is a contact fungicide. It is used on freshly cut lumber.

Sinesto B will prevent mildew stains (bluing) and transportation staining. It is not intended for use on the use site. It is used with water and sprayed on freshly cut lumber. Dilute solution may be used for spraying. The wood should be dry within 24 hours.

Wear rubber gloves when handling Sinesto B on lumber.

Sinesto B should be used at 10 and 30 parts per million on the severity of staining. Vigorous stirring is required. A board test is required to determine the optimum dilution. The dilution should be at least 10 parts per million.

Treated wood should be protected after treatment. In inclement weather, the wood must be roofed, drained to prevent water, and anti-sap stain solution should be applied to the application. Properly maintained.

Treated sawdust should be disposed of properly.
