

POOLCIDE


Poolcide will control algae and bacterial slime common to swimming pools and open recirculating water systems. Poolcide cleans slime, black oil films on poolsides. No other microbiocide is needed with Poolcide at suggested dosages. Poolcide is compatible with chlorine and would eliminate high chlorine residual for control of algae and black slime.

CAUTION

Poolcide should be kept out of reach of children. Poolcide has a low order of toxicity to humans and is non-irritating to skin and eyes at use concentrations. Warning do not get in direct contact with skin and eyes, wash all skin surfaces after use.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

DIRECTIONS

For Control of Algae, Bacterial Slime. Use Poolcide as directed.

Best results at start up slug feed Poolcide to stabilize other pool chemicals and eliminate algae and slime. To optimize your use of Poolcide follow this procedure:

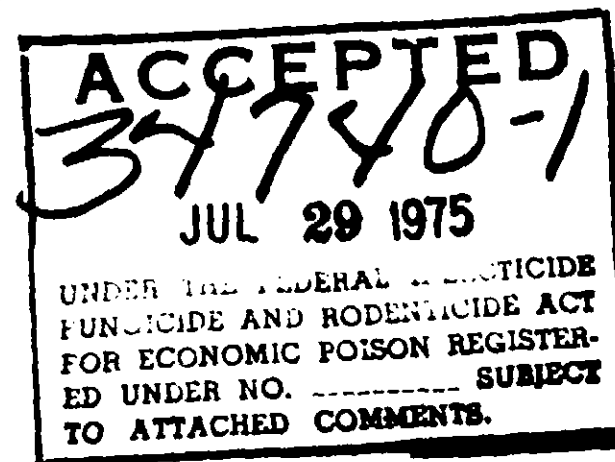
Step 1. Initial dose, use 1 gallon Poolcide per 20,000 gallons of water. If algae or slime is not present, use one-half gallon Poolcide per 20,000 gallons, for the first 24 hours of operation.

Step 2. Maintain weekly dosage of one quart per 20,000 gallons of water for maximum clean algae free water. Add 1 pint per 40,000 gallons after rain during 24 hours. Feed Poolcide directly to pool, evenly for complete mixing.

A SOLUTION FOR DISINFECTION OF WATER IN WHIRLPOOL BATHS

RECOMMENDED USE:

For routine disinfection — first fill tank with water, then add approximately one (1) fluid ounce (30 c.c.) of PHARMADINE FOR WHIRLPOOLS for each twenty gallons of water. NOTE: Thyroid function tests of some patients may be affected. Drain and clean tank after each use.
