**DIRECTIONS FOR USE  
IN COOLING TOWERS**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**INITIAL APPLICATION:** Prior to the use of *A-59* systems should be cleaned to remove microbials, sludges, dirt and other environmental debris. Then add an initial dose of 0.3 - 0.9 lbs. per 1000 gallons system water to the point of greatest turbulence in the cooling tower basin or sump.

Do not dilute prior to addition to the system. Repeat the dosage as often as necessary to maintain a free chlorine residual of at least 1.0 ppm for four hours.

**SUBSEQUENT APPLICATION:** After microbial growth control is evident, add 0.1 - 0.3 lbs. per 1000 gallons system water to the point of greatest turbulence in the cooling tower basin or sump. Do not dilute prior to addition to the system. Repeat the dosage as often as necessary to maintain a free chlorine residual of at least 1.0 ppm for four hours.

The frequency of addition depends upon the amount of system turbulence and the quality of the water being treated. Most systems require at least one treated 2-4 times per week.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Keep product tightly closed in container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat and moisture. Do not use in confined spaces or near large quantities of combustibles. Do not use in areas where there are large quantities of organic materials. Do not use in areas where there are large quantities of food or other organic materials.
