### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic invertebrates. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Drift and runoff from treated sites may be hazardous to fish in adjacent waters. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

#### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Control of Bees, Hornets, Wasps and Yellowjackets: It is preferable to apply this product in the evening after all the insects have returned to the nest. Aim valve opening at the nest and depress button, continuing to spray until the nest is soaked with the spray. Repeat as necessary.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.  
**DISPOSAL:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
