POTATO SEED PIECE TREATMENT—To control Seed Decay (Fusarium), Damping-Off. Apply sufficient amount of CAPTAN 5% POTATO SEED TREATER to provide thorough coverage. Use 1 to 2 pounds of this product per bushel of cut seed. Whole or 1-drop seed will need less material. Depending on the number of cuts made in the seed piece, the amount of dust used will vary as a result of the number of surface areas exposed for treatment. CAPTAN 5% POTATO SEED TREATER will NOT protect against fungal inoculum already within the tuber or bacterial diseases. Dust seed pieces before planting, but pieces should be treated within 6 hours of cutting.
