

## METHOD OF APPLICATION DIRECTIONS FOR USE

WHEAT, OATS, BARLEY, RYE—Use rate of 2 ounces per bushel.

FLAX—Use rate of 4 ounces per bushel.

CORN, SOYBEANS—Use rate of 3 ounces per bushel.

### Planter or Drill Box Treatment

For best results fill planter or drill box one-half of seed, then treat with one-half amount of Maneb-Lindane Seed Protectant and mix well by stirring with stick or paddle until color is imparted to all seed. Add remaining seed to the planter box and cover with balance of Maneb-Lindane Seed Protectant, mix thoroughly as above. DO NOT MIX WITH BARE HANDS.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Move the KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN to a position appearing immediately above the front panel signal word.
2. A STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT must be added to the labeling. We suggest the following statement, however, if your toxicological data suggests otherwise, please submit a draft STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT for prior approval:

"STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed-Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled- Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin- Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water.

If in eyes- Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists."

3. Under number 6 on the left panel change "shold" to "should".
4. Delete "Do not use treated seed for feed...purposes." and insert:

34704-57

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"Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil. Treat only those seeds needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting. Do not store excess treated seeds beyond planting time."

4. Insert the following to immediately follow the heading DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

"It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling."

5. Insert a "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" section in accordance with PR Notices 83-3 and 84-1.
6. Immediately preceding "CAUTION Caution must be observed..." insert the following headings:

"PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

"HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS"

7. Immediately preceding "This product is toxic to fish..." insert the following heading:

"ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS"

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until April 1, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
