CAUTION**

Causes eye and skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. **STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Induce vomiting by giving two glasses of water and touching back of throat. Get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.  
If in eyes: Immediately flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention for irritation.  
If on skin: Wash promptly with soap and water. Remove and launder contaminated clothing before reuse.  
If inhaled: Remove from exposure and assist respiration if needed.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Drift or runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

CLEAN CROP THIRAM-MOLY Seed Protectant is specially formulated for planter box application on soybeans and other legumes. When used as directed, this product protects the seeds from decay, seedling blight and damping off. Molybdenum is involved in the nitrogen fixation process that occurs in the nodules of legume plants.

**PLANTER OR DRILL BOX USE**

Place 1/2 of the seed in planter or drill box and sprinkle 1/2 the total amount of CLEAN CROP THIRAM-MOLY Seed Protectant over the seed, mix with paddle or stick until color is imparted to the seed. Add remaining 1/2 of seed and this product and stir as outlined above.

**USE RATE**

Soybeans—Use 2 ounces per bushel (10 ounces can treat 5 bushels of soybean seed). Alfalfa, Clover and other small seeded legumes—Use 57 ounces per 50-pound bag.
