**WORK SAFETY RULES** 

The National Pesticide Telecommunication Network is available for recommendations regarding poisoning management, emergency treatment, and other information regarding the loxicity of methyl parathion. The toll free number for the National Pesticide Telecommunication Network is 1-800-858-7378.

If handled indoors provide mechanical exhaust ventilation. Keep all unprotected persons, children, livestock, and pets away from treated area or where there is danger of drift. Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. If you feel sick in any way, STOP work and get help right away, See First Ald (Statement of Practical Treatment) section.

HANDLE THE CONCENTRATE ONLY WHEN WEARING THE FOL-LOWING PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT:

Wear a protective suit of one or two pieces that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands, and feet. Wear chemical resistant gloves, chemical resistant apron, and chemical resistant shoes, shoe coverings, or boots. Wear goggles or a face shield. Wear a nasticide respirator approved by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR part II.

REFER TO PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS ABOVE.

IMPORTANT! If pesticide comes in contact with skin, wash off with soap and water and contact a physician immediately. Always wash hands, face, and arms with soap and water before smoking, eating, drinking, or toileting.

AFTER WORK: before removing gioves, wash them with soap and water. Take off all work clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Wear only clean clothes when leaving job—do not wear contaminated clothing. Personal clothing work during work must be stored and laundered separately from protective clothing and household articles. Store protective clothing separately from personal riothing. Clean or launder protective clothing after each use. Respirators must be cleaned and filters replaced accurding to instructions included with the respirators. Protective clothing and protective equipment heavily contaminated or elemented with methyl parathlon must be destroyed accurding to instructions. POISON SIGNS (Symptoms)

Methyl Parathion is a very dangerous poison. It rapidly enterethe biddy on contact with all skin surfaces and eyes. Clothing way with this material must be removed immediately. Exposed persons must receive prompt medical treatment or they may die.

Some of the signs and symptoms of poisoning are: Headache, any Ber, vomiting, cramps, weakness, blurred vision, pin-pint pupils, tightness in chest, labored brauthing, nervousness, sweeting, prepring of the eyes, drooling or frothing of mouth and nose, muscle spasses and come.

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## STATEMENT OF + PRACTICAL TREATMENT +

Call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to methyl parathion and describe his condition. If breathing has stopped, start artifical respiration immediately and maintain until doctor sees victim.

If eventowed—Drink 1 to 2 gleenes of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or akin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. See doctor immuliately.

#### **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN**

Antidote—Administer etropine sulfate in large dose.

TWO to FOUR mg. Intravenously or inframuscularly as soon as cyanosis is overcome. Repeat at 5 to 10 m/mute intervals until signs of abropinization appear, 2-PAM chloride is also antidotal and may be administered in curjunction with atropine. DO NOT GIVE MORPHINE OR TRANOUILIZERS. Methyl Parathion is a strong cholinesterase inhibitor affecting the central and peripheral nervous systems and producing cardiac and respiratory depression. At first sign of pulmonary ed-ma, the patient should be given supplemental drygen and treated symptomatically. Continued absorption of the poison may occur and fatal relapses have been reported after initial improvement; VERY CLOSE SUPERVISION OF THE PATIENT IS INDICATED FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This pesticide is highly toxic to aquatic invertebrates and wildlife. Birds in treated areas may be killed. Shrimp and other aquatic organisms may be killed at recommended application rates. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshee and potholes), unless otherwise permitted in Directions For Use. Runoff and drift from target areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in adjacent aquatic sites. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wester.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.


