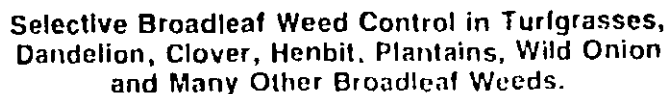
PROHIBITIONS. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container. Do not store in unapproved locations which might adversely affect the container's ability to function properly.

STORAGE: Do not store below temperature of 35°F in a safe manner. Store in original container only. Store in cool, dry place. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Reentry stacking to light where local conditions can affect package strength. Personnel should use clothing and equipment consistent with good practice handling.

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For selective control of broadleaf weeds in tallgrasses such as those found on lawns and golf courses. Not for use on Cernia Cernia, Cernia, St. Augustine, Birdgrass or other turf grasses where desirable flowers are present. Newly seeded areas should not be treated until after second mowing. Treated areas may be reseeded 3 to 4 weeks after treatment.

Apply as a foliar spray for the control of broadleaf weeds, including dandelion, clovers, henbit, plantain (b. thorn and broadleaf), wild garlic and wild onion. Best results are obtained when weeds are young and actively growing in the spring and fall. Avoid applications during hot, dry weather when weed growth is slow. Do not water for 24 hours after treatment. Apply at a rate of 2.2-2.85 pints per acre in sufficient spray solution to provide uniform coverage (1/2 to 4 gallons per 1000 sq. ft.).

Avoid use on bermudagrass turf in late spring and summer as discoloration of turf is likely. Use of this product within the dripline of desirable trees and shrubs could cause injury. Do not spray exposed roots of ornamental trees and shrubs. Do not allow spray solution or spray drift to contact foliage of desirable trees, shrubs, flowers, or vegetables as injury will likely result.
