Your Letters Dated February 11, 1986, April 24, 1986, May 24, 1988, September 19, 1989 and September 10, 1991

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

Revise the first paragraph of the Environmental Hazards statement as follows:

This pesticide is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water, areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Drift and runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to fish in neighboring areas. Do not contaminate when disposing of equipment washwater.

- Under the "Seed Treatment Dosage Rates" table, revise 2. Grass (Safflower, Rye, Sudan) to appear as 3 separate entries, specifically Safflower, Rye, Sudangrass. Note that "Rye" should no appear as "Ryegrass" since it is a "Grass" should not appear on the different crop and labeling since a tolerance is not established for this crop.
- 3. Since this product is intended for use in treating seed and can be used by commercial seed treaters, the label must bear a statement requiring the user to add an EPA-
