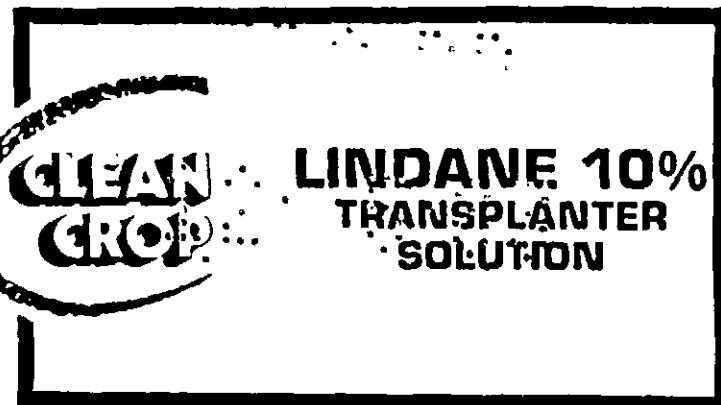
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use only as directed—CLEAN CROP LINDANE 10% TRANSPLANTER SOLUTION is a special formulation made especially for use in transplanting water against wireworms. It should be mixed thoroughly with water and will stay in suspension without agitation during the transplanting operation. The transplanter solution establishes a zone of protection against wireworms around the roots of newly set plants. This allows the roots and the new plants to become established.

TOBACCO: Wireworms—Use 1 to 2 fluid ounces (2 to 4 tablespoonfuls) in 50 gals. of transplanting water, depending on the type of soil. Apply at the rate of 1/2 pint to the plant or about 200 to 250 gallons of mixture to the acre.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Move the KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN to a position appearing immediately above the front panel signal word.
2. A STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT must be added to the labeling. We suggest the following statement, however, if your toxicological data suggests otherwise, please submit a draft STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT for prior approval:

"STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed—Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING: vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

If inhaled— Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin— Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes— Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN—Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally."

2. Since there is potential exposure from the use of this product add the following protective clothing statement: Applicators must wear the following protective clothing: a lightweight protective suit or coveralls, unlined water-proof gloves and lightweight boots. Mixers and loaders must also wear goggles or a face shield, water-proof gloves and a water-proof apron.

3. Insert the following to immediately follow the heading DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

"It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling."

4. Insert a "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" section in accordance with PR Notices 83-3 and 84-1. (Delete your present inadequate statement.)
5. Immediately preceding "CAUTION Harmful if swallowed..." insert the following headings:

"PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

"HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS"

6. Add the following to the "HAZARDS TO HUMANS..." section:

"Wash hands thoroughly after using and before eating or smoking."

7. Immediately preceding "Do not use, pour, spill....flame.", insert the following heading:

"PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS"

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until ~~April~~ 1, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
