

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Use on Alfalfa – For the control of alfalfa weevil larvae, grass-hopper, aphids, including spotted alfalfa aphid, lygus bugs, leaf-hoppers, spider mites, spittlebugs, vetch bruchids on alfalfa, apply 2 quarts of Alfalfa Weevil Larvae Spray per acre in sufficient water for good coverage as a diluted spray.

For the control of Armyworms, apply 5 pints per acre.

Repeat applications as necessary. Apply this product to alfalfa in bloom only in the evening or early morning when bees are not working in the field or are not hanging on the outside of the hives.

Do not cut or graze within 7 days of application.
