DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TCMATOES: Early blight, late blight, Septoria leaf spot, gray leaf spot (Stimphylium) anthracnose, leafhopper, serpentine leaf miner, whitefly and aphids. Apply when fruit of first clusters is well formed or when intects first appear, at the rate of 20 pounds per acre. Repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals. (Do not use on young seedlings in greenhouses as injury may occur.) When weather conditions favor disease, more frequent applications may be necessary, starting when plants are set in fields. Do not apply within 10 days of harvest.
